GP, pharmacist, practice nurse or clinical specialist observes the patient completing the following steps and scores 1 (satisfactory) or 0 (not satisfactory) depending on whether the step is completed satisfactorily

1	For use in children UNDER the age of 4						
2	Remove the mouthpiece cover from the metered dose inhaler						
3	Shake inhaler and insert into the inhaler holder of Babyhaler						
4	Place the facemask gently over the baby's mouth and nose, ensuring there is a good seal between the mask and face.						
5	Hold the Babyhaler and inhaler at an angle that is comfortable for adult and baby.						
6	... press the inhaler canister once to release a dose of the drug						
7	Keep Babyhaler facemask over the mouth and nose until the baby has inhaled at least 5-10 breaths. (The blue values will move slightly as the baby breathes in and out).						
8	Remove the facemask from the baby's face.						
9	If a second dose is required at this point, wait 30-60 seconds before repeating stages 2 to 8. (If a second dose is not required at this point reviewer adds 1 point to score.)						
10	Remove inhaler from Babyhaler device and replace cap. Especially if a controller inhaler is used, rinse mouth after use
